APPOINTMENT OF DATES FOR VARIOUS STAGES AND FIXATION OF HOURS OF POLL FOR BIENNIAL ELECTIONS TO THE COUNCIL OF STATES TO FILL VACANCIES OF MEMBERS RETIRING DURING JUNE, 2022

The following Notification of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi, dated: 24th May, 2022 [Jyaishtha 03, 1944 (Saka)] is republished:-

No. 318/CS-Multi/2/2022(1):- Whereas, the President of India has, by notification issued under Section 12 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951(43 of 1951) and published in the Gazette of India on 24th May, 2022 been pleased to call upon the elected members of each of the Legislative Assemblies of the States, specified in column (1) of the TABLE below, to elect to the Council of States, the number of member(s) specified against that State in column (2) of the said TABLE:

- (A) appoints, with respect to the said election;
  - (a) the 31st May, 2022 (Tuesday), as the last date for making nominations;
  - (b) the 01st June, 2022 (Wednesday), as the date for the scrutiny of the nominations;
  - (c) the 03rd June, 2022 (Friday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
  - (d) the 10th June, 2022 (Friday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and
  - (e) the 13th June, 2022 (Monday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and
- (B) fixes the hours from 09:00 am to 04:00 pm, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken in all the above mentioned States on the date specified above for the election.
